I purchased the property 5 years ago, falling in love with some established trees and shrubs with a back drop of some large indigenous gums and the neighbour's ancient Ash tree which overhangs in my garden.

I quickly incorporated my own style of garden...a rambling country cottage probably best describes it.....fruit trees, veggies, natives and exotics. However, the garden is diverse with a large pond home to ducks, several species of frogs and native birds including blue wrens, honey eaters, fantails, kookaburras and red brow finches to name a few.

We also have a registered bee hive and extracted honey for the first time last year. The hive is almost 2 years old and they arrived as a swarm in the top garden 2 days before we got married.

No artificial chemicals or spray are used in the garden. The chooks and ducks take care of that!

The garden is under irrigation even though we have a good rainfall in the hills but I still like to water with the hose as sometimes you can actually miss something.

I use natural fertilisers and basically anything I can get my hands on, cow, horse poo and chook poo and spent hay.

So, enjoy the day...the house which was built in the late 1800's and I will be on site if there are any questions you wish to ask.
