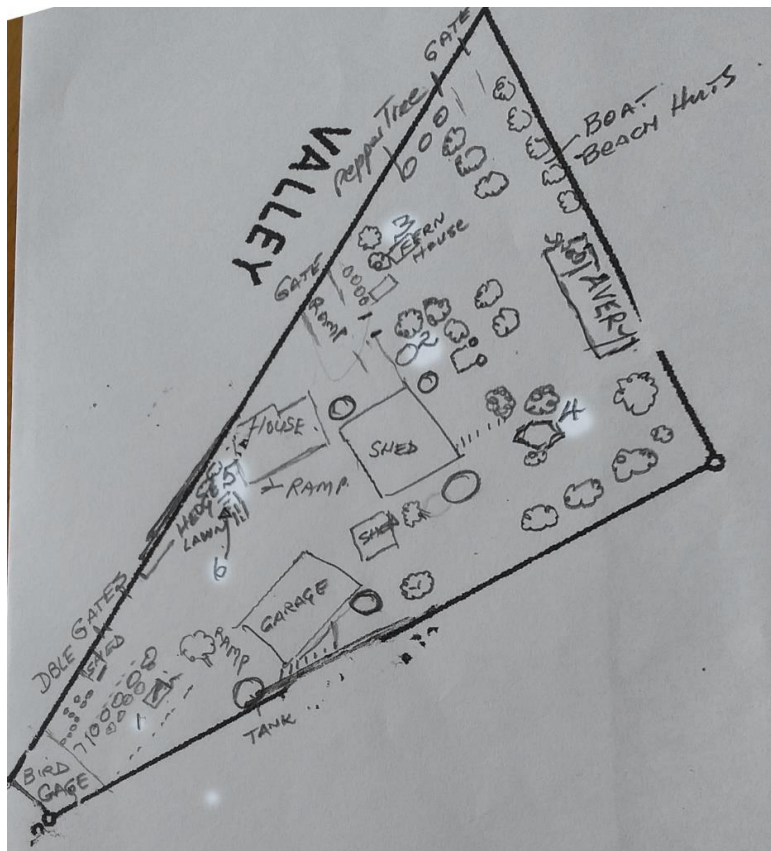
We have named our property **SOJOURN** which means dwell, linger or stay a while.
